Find an artistic expression of what means "to be Protestant" in your school.

Start looking for traces and collect data, facts and background information about the foundation of your school.

In 2017, we will celebrate the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Reformation. Select an event or a thought which is particularly important for the life, the learning and the faith at your school.

What historical events took place at the time when your school was founded?

Interview witnesses.

Search in the school archives for pictures and reports.

The family tree of the churches, the time bar of the history of the Reformation, the core events of this time or the quotes from Protestant reformers can help you in this.
