- Select an event or a thought from the Reformation which is particularly important for the life, the learning and the faith at your school.



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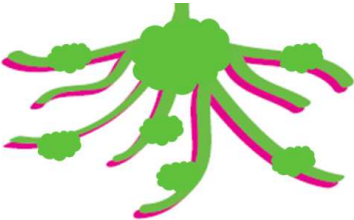
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Start looking for traces and collect data, facts and background information about the foundation of your school.
